Clothing & Shoes

- Boys: 3 button up shirts (short or long)
- Girls: 2 Long skirts or long dress
- 6 T-Shirts
- 3 Shorts (1 khaki dress short)
- 6 Socks
- 6 Underwear
- 2 Long pants
- 2 Sweatshirts or pullovers
- 1 Lightweight jacket and/or fleece
- Sun hat or baseball cap

Dress Clothes for Church, Divine Liturgy & Camp Photos

- Dress clothing for church (i.e. knee length skirts, dresses, dress pants/slacks, collared shirts short or long sleeves, blouses. **No ripped jeans, flip flops or hats, please.**)
- Due to the terrain, Dress Shoes will NOT BE REQUIRED THIS YEAR. Casual Shoes are allowed.

Cabin & Toiletries

- Bedding (Bed Cover, Sheets, and Blanket) **AND/OR** Sleeping Bag (*Can get cold at night*)
- Pillow
- Toothbrush

- Deodorant
- Bath Towels (One for showers, one for the pool).
- Beach Towel OR Blanket for the Grass
- Sunscreen (Non-Aerosol)

★ **Basic Shampoo, Conditioner, and Toothpaste WILL BE provided for ALL CAMPERS (feel free to pack your own if you want).**

Prescription Medication & Health

- Must be turned in during registration/check-in. Medications will be administered by the camp nurse at the proper time.
- Glasses/Contacts

★ Highly Recommended Items

- **FLASHLIGHT or HEADLAMP (This camp site can be very dark at night)!**
- Hats/Caps
- Inexpensive Camera
- Up to \$20.00 for eating out
 - **Camp THY will not be responsible for lost/mishandled money**
- Reusable Water Bottle/Canteen
 - *We will not be providing water bottles, please bring your own.*
- Lip Balm/Chapstick

Packing Tips

- Label **EVERYTHING!** Use the Camp THY Travel Tags on the last page of this document!
- **Don't** pack anything of value.

- Each camper should have their own suitcase, we **discourage** shared suitcases between siblings.

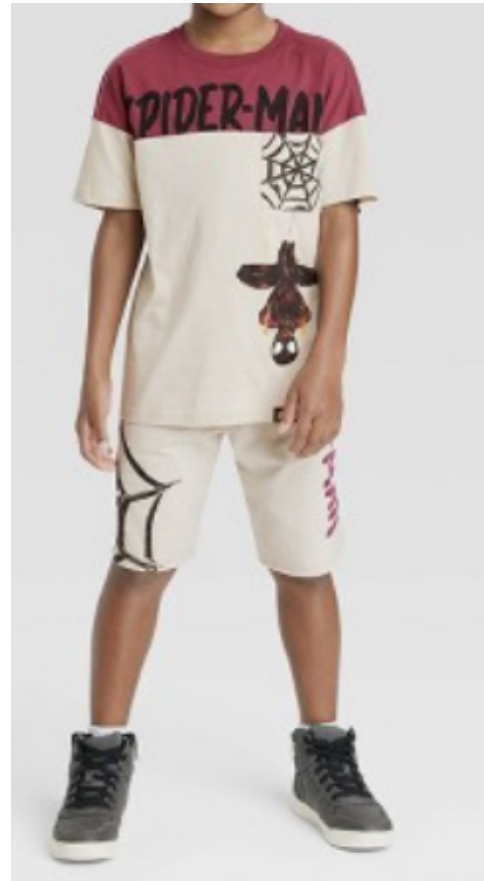
Special Note about Cell Phones:

- *Campers are not allowed to have cell phones at camp. While it may seem counter-intuitive, we have found that campers who bring cell phones have a harder time adjusting to camp life and can have more difficulty with homesickness. A large part of camp is learning to be independent and you can help your children succeed by making sure he/she does not bring a cell phone.*
- *However, if your child would like to have a phone for traveling purposes, we will gladly keep it for him/her in the office until closing day. Please let the staff know if we should expect your child to have one.*
